Updates from members' programs

- Sara (Longwood) Worked over the summer to develop professional studies courses with EI content. This type of coursework can lead to endorsements. Hope to have everything approved by Spring. Currently offering courses as a pilot.
- Sharon (Radford) RU's undergrad ECSE program is really struggling but has over 70 grad students. Have moved to 7-week classes and are in a consortium with Lynchburg. We also have grant funds.
- We might need to consider recruitment even at middle and high school ages to draw students to EI. DEC has an <u>EI recruitment</u> video.
- Dana (ODU) Undergrad and grad online programs are shifting to 8-week asynchronous courses.

Updates from ITCVA

- Terri (ITCVA) Added disciplines in mental health that can see children. Practice Manual has been updated and will be out for public comment soon. Be sure to be added to the monthly email distribution list.
- Cori As of August, <u>VEIPD website</u> has moved to a different platform that is more accessible and mobile friendly. Certification courses were also moved to Canvas.

- Action Plan (ITEMS HIGHLIGHTED IN BLUE ARE TODAY'S PRIORITIES)
 - Goal One: Celebrate the variety of needs and cultivate relationships between Virginia Universities and local El systems
 - Safiya and Terri led the discussion. Proposed new goal language: Goal One: Increase the number of students graduating from Virginia universities, from all recognized disciplines (i.e., OT, PT, SPL, ECE, ECSE, education, counseling, social work, etc.) who become Early Intervention practitioners in Virginia's early intervention workforce statewide. All approved this new wording.
 - Revised to focus on increasing graduation of students in all disciplines who get hired in EI in VA
 - See action plan for new objectives
 - Do we want to invite LSMs to join the group as a whole or to work on specific goals?
 - Maybe 1 LSM per TA region? Or have a leader from the LSMs join each meeting and they could rotate? Or have 1-2 LSMs agree to join for the semester/year and then rotate?
 - Maybe invite them to the portion of the meeting that applies to them?
 - We would need to balance the purpose of the meeting and ensure everyone is able to participate.
 - We might have more LSMs who are also adjunct instructors who want to hear higher ed info.
 - Consider how many people we invite with the challenges of managing scheduling these meetings.
 - It would be important to onboard the LSM(s).

- Recommendation: Invite 2 LSMs/leaders to join the Consortium as members. Could have additional LSMs to join workgroups if needed.
 Terri will coordinate to determine the LSMs.
- MOUs LSMs didn't think their executive directors would agree to a single MOU template but we will keep working on this.
- Terri and Safiya will facilitate the goal along with two LSMs.
 Sharon will join the work.
- Next collaborative meeting with LSMs will be in October.
- Goal Two: Establish an Infrastructure to collaborate across universities and systems to enhance high quality research to practice partnerships
 - 2.1 (Lead: Yaoying, Members: Terri, Michelle, Christian, Sara, Alison, Sonia) Conduct a survey on El service providers about how Al has been used in their work
 - Survey on AI use in EI has been distributed through the Part C Update to EI distribution list.
 We have only received less than 10 responses so far. Suggestions are welcome to increase response rate to 100-200 respondents. Plan to close survey by early December to begin analysis. Results will be shared at the CRIEI conference.
 - VEIPD can send out the survey directly to the list serv. Terri sent the info to send out to Cori.
 - Should we have a standard acknowledgement statement for the Consortium to include in publications?
 - Yaoying will send Cori some sample statements.
 - 2.2 (Lead: Yaoying, Members: Terri, Michelle, Christian, Sara, Alison, Sonia) Conduct a survey with El families about how Al has been used in the context of receiving El services

- 2.4 Carryout activities for OSEP 325N Grant-Workforce Ready: Supporting Community College Faculty to Prepare Scholars Serving Diverse Young Children with Disabilities (Leads: Christine and Cori; Heather, Dana, Christian, Terri)
 - After much nail-biting, we <u>did</u> get continued funding for next year which begins 10/1/25.
 - Significant work being completed on faculty toolkits to embed more disability-related information into assignments.
