



Plan each day carefully! - Plan visits in the same area on the same day whenever possible. Plan enough time for travel between visits.



Show respect for the family's time by arriving and leaving on time. If you must be late, be sure to give the family a quick call or send a text to let them know.



Park your car in a way that ensures an easy exit (facing the street, park on the street rather than the driveway, be sure not to get blocked in or towed).



Never talk about other families during your visit. Avoid conversations by the car.



- Be aware of family-specific or cultural considerations (i.e., take shoes off at the door).
  - Avoid bringing valuables into the home (purse/wallet, jewelry).
- Bring extra copies of important forms (e.g., Parental Prior Notice, IFSP Review Record, Rights document).
- **3** Document visits as soon as possible following the visit (must be completed within 5 days according to the Practice Manual).
  - Always make sure someone knows where you are going and when you will be back.
    - Always remember that you are a guest in the family's home!
