 - Federal Updates:
 - Proposed budget keeps Part C separate from the rest of the IDEA consolidation/Block Grant
 - Level funded
 - Could change Part C access to TA these activities are proposed to be lumped into the Block Grant
 - Watching Medicaid and potential impacts to families we serve and El programs
 - Some of these proposals would require congressional approval
 - Local Systems Pyramid Model implementation plans
