Dimensions is a 7-session short course designed to introduce the fundamentals of early intervention (EI) practice that are essential for all service providers to understand.

Dimensions enrolls new service providers with less than 18-months experience in El for 7, 90-minutes sessions for a total of 10.5 professional development contact hours. This evaluation assesses the impact of the pilot version of the Dimensions short course.
