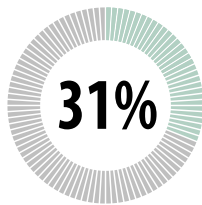

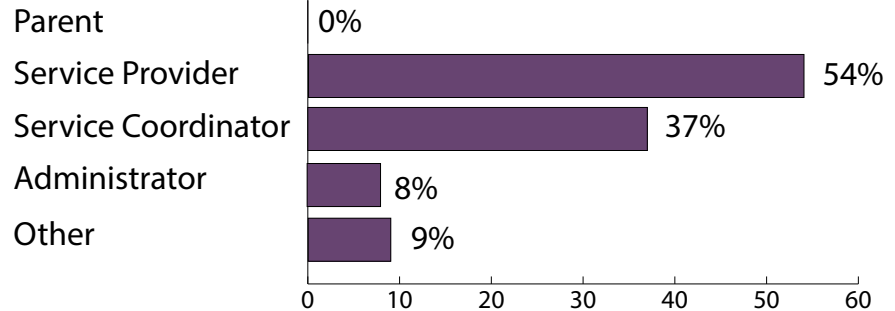

HOW will you use the information you learned?

Participants overall mentioned they learned:

- To interact directly with children and families
- Increased awareness of possible early signs of autism and preparedness to discuss with families
- Further appreciation in tools for families seeking a diagnosis and facing long wait lists
