

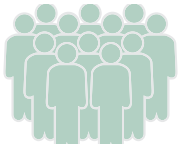

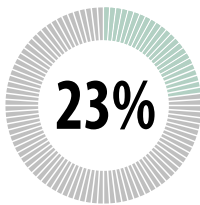

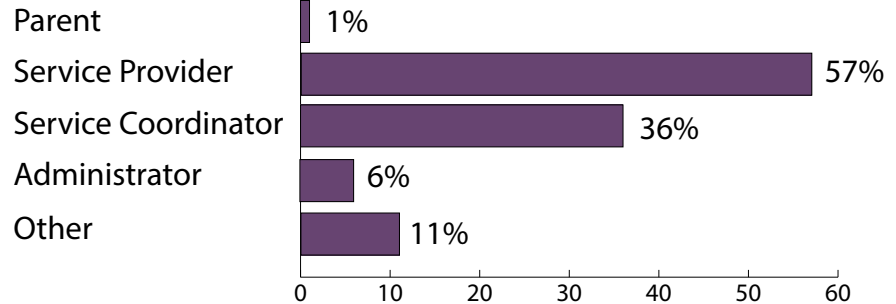

HOW will you use the information you learned?

Participants overall mentioned they learned:

- To incorporate "tips and tricks" into evaluations
- To recognize signs earlier, using the M-CHAT and asking follow up questions
- To have improved conversations
- To explain observations and developmental differences to families and caregivers
- To apply practical application strategies

I will use the information learned to better serve my families through their EI services. As an occupational therapist, I often use a lot of "floortime" approaches, and the presenters provided excellent strategies for how to explain some of the typical and atypical behaviors we may see during these floortime sessions. They helped me to navigate what is normal versus what needs more questions/attention.

I appreciate all of the early signs and examples provided. This will help me provide up to date information to my families on characteristics to look out for.
